





Students should **only** be using a graduation checklist (like this one) to assess their graduation progress. Tools like Degree Works and even Bison Hub may not be an accurate assessment of your matriculation.



Students (Non-Freshmen) should download a copy of their unofficial transcript from Bison Web while the system is still active. There may be updates and changes that are missing in your Bison Hub Academic History.



Students should MEET with an advisor at least once a semester (WE WELCOME MORE!!!) Here's why......
