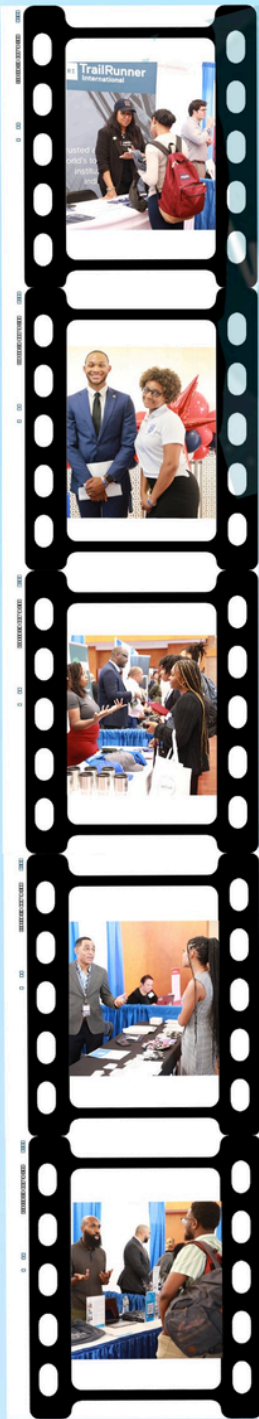

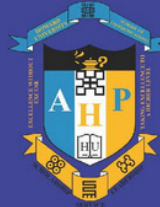

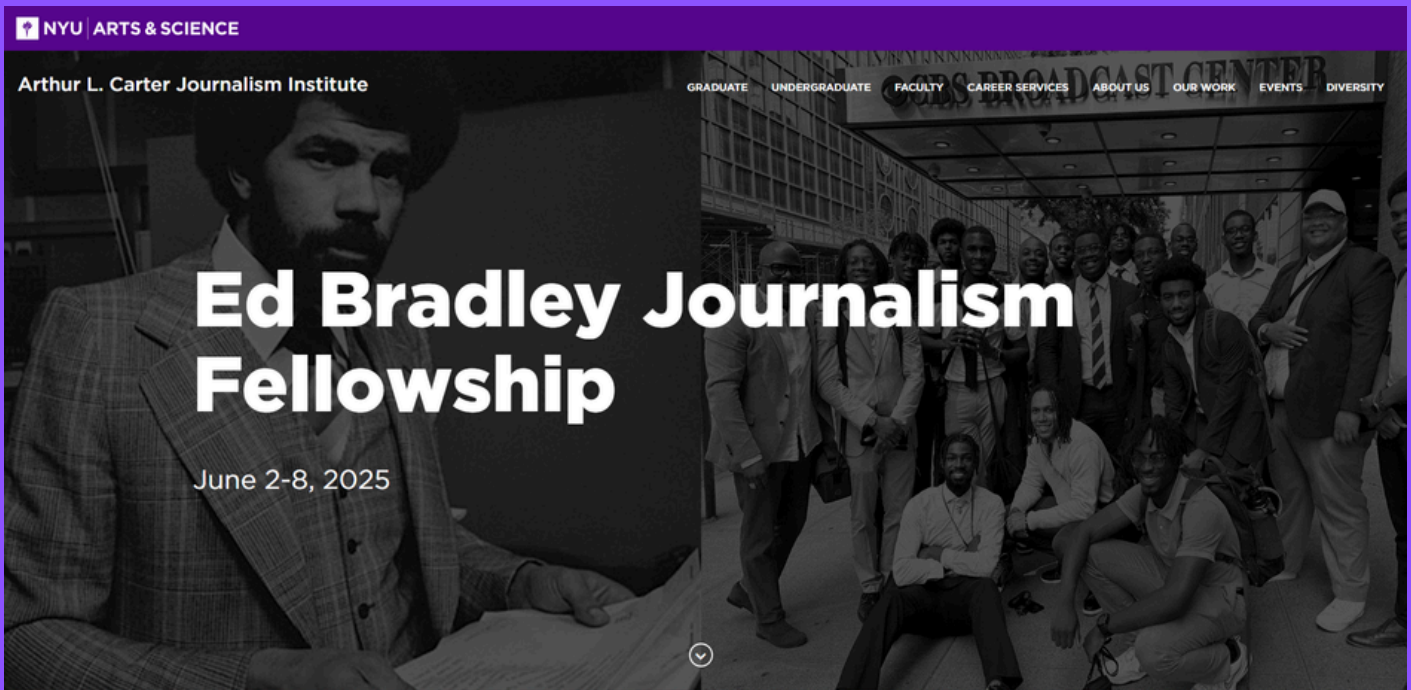

TIP #2

Students (Non-Freshmen) should download a copy of their unofficial transcript from Bison Web while the system is still active. There may be updates and changes that are missing in your Bison Hub Academic History.

TIP #3

Students should **MEET** with an advisor at least once a semester (WE WELCOME MORE!!!) Here's why.....

- ADVISORS CAN HELP STUDENTS CONDUCT DEGREE AUDITS TO SEE IF THEY ARE ON TRACK TO COMPLETE THEIR REQUIRED CREDITS AND RECEIVE THEIR DEGREE ON TIME.
- ADVISORS CAN HELP STUDENTS NAVIGATE THE REGISTRATION PROCESS, INCLUDING PROVIDING INFORMATION ON REGISTRATION BLOCKS AND HOW TO REMOVE THEM.

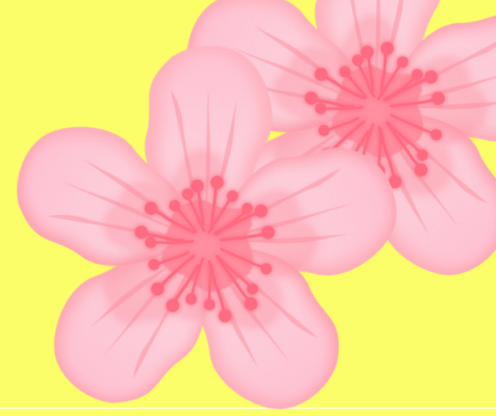
